Onsite Facilities

Leisure Suite

A key and popular feature of the Leisure Suite is our 15m Swimming Pool that has ramps for access to ensure it remains accessible to all.

Residential groups may be offered an evening session in the pool. Groups can pre book the swimming pool for their own private sessions.

Catering

We have a catering team onsite all year round. Residential groups will be provided with breakfast, lunch and dinner that will be served and eaten in our dining room. Any dietary requirements can be catered for, these must be highlighted before the visit. If schools are trying to keep costs down we are happy for groups to bring their own packed lunches.

Our Village Cafe is open daily and serves breakfast and lunch as well as tea/coffee and sweet treats.



Accommodation

Pupils and teachers will stay in our onsite accessible accommodation. We have a mix of chalets and bedrooms. Most bedrooms are made up of 2 double bunks with an ensuite. Groups will be provided a common room that the children can relax in during free time.



Play Parks

When the pupils are not doing an instructor-led activity, they can play in any of our 2 play parks or have a game of football on our football pitch.

Upon arrival all residential guests will be given a welcome talk by an Instructor that will highlight the rules of our site and get a tour of the site. Teachers can add to the rules and regulations of the visit.
